THE LORD'S SUPPER: OUR UNDERSTANDING AND PRACTICE

The Lord's Supper is celebrated at this congregation in the confession and glad confidence that, as he says, our Lord gives into our mouths not only bread and wine but his very body and blood to eat and to drink for the forgiveness of sins and to strengthen our union with him and with one another. Our Lord invites to his table those who trust his words, repent of all sin, and set aside any refusal to forgive and love as he forgives and loves us, that they may show forth his death until he comes. Because those who eat and drink our Lord's body and blood unworthily do so to their great harm and because Holy Communion is a confession of the faith which is confessed at this altar, any who are not yet instructed, in doubt, or who are members of a different church other than The Lutheran Church—Missouri Synod, and yet desire to receive the sacrament, are asked first to speak with the pastor. For further study see Matt 5:23f.; 10:32f.; 18:15-35; 26:26-29; 1 Cor 11:17-34.

ADVANCING THE GOSPEL PRAYER CORNER

Each week throughout this campaign kick-off, we will be highlighting the prayer requests of various ministries that take place on our campus day in and day out throughout each week. Please keep these in mind as you go through your week and present them to God with your own prayers and petitions.

Lord we ask that You bless those who lead our many Bible studies that they may confidently share your Word with those eager to learn and understand your purpose for us as we show You to those who do not know You. Pray also that more hearts and minds are drawn to these studies so that Your Word will be shared more profusely throughout our community.

MISSION MOMENT

One way to start a faith conversation and be a Christian witness is to simply talk about what you did over the weekend!

- 1. Start by asking others what they did last weekend. Then, describe your weekend and include going to worship. It is ok to say I/we went to church, but later in the chitchat include worshipping God.
- 2. Describe at least one thing that was meaningful to you. It could be the Bible readings about singing to the Lord, or Jesus as the Rock of your salvation. Perhaps something from the sermon: Jesus is our mediator! OR that in worship we receive from God ... then we respond. OR what an honor it is to "approach the throne of God!" Or to teach your children about the meaning of worship. OR that you are filled up and empowered for the week after hearing God's Word.
- 3. Follow up with a question to keep the conversation going. Have you ever gone to church? Why or why not? Do not worry about a negative response. You have just shared a positive that the Holy Spirit will use!
- 4. Follow up later with a question about Jesus such as: "You said church wasn't your thing. Is that how you feel about Jesus or is that different?"

Come let us sing for joy to the Lord: let us shout aloud to the Rock of our salvation!
