The Lord's Supper: Our Understanding and Practice

The Lord's Supper is celebrated at this congregation in the confession and glad confidence that, as he says, our Lord gives into our mouths not only bread and wine but his very body and blood to eat and to drink for the forgiveness of sins and to strengthen our union with him and with one another. Our Lord invites to his table those who trust his words, repent of all sin, and set aside any refusal to forgive and love as he forgives and loves us, that they may show forth his death until he comes. Because those who eat and drink our Lord's body and blood unworthily do so to their great harm and because Holy Communion is a confession of the faith which is confessed at this altar, any who are not yet instructed, in doubt, or who are members of a different church other than The Lutheran Church—Missouri Synod, and yet desire to receive the sacrament, are asked first to speak with the pastor. For further study see Matt 5:23f.; 10:32f.; 18:15-35; 26:26-29; 1 Cor 11:17-34.

Mission Moment

The time is here! The time is now! Jesus has risen and it is a matter of life and death – life now and life forever! Pass this Good News on! People are often open to invitations to church just before Easter! We have several unique opportunities!

- You Have Been Egged! (No mess involved!) This is a fun, easy way to involve the whole family! Simply hide plastic eggs with candy in your neighbor's or friend's front yard. Hang the sign on the front door! Ruth has all needed supplies & easy instructions outside! The sign explains why you are hiding the eggs in a cheerful poem. On the sign, you write the number of eggs that you have hidden and sign your name. The sign ALSO includes Easter worship times and an invitation to come!
- Hand out Easter postcards Give to a friend, co-worker, clerk at store, etc. Say: "This is Who gives me hope!" "Hope you can come!"
- Mail a postcard to friend or family. Star the service you will attend. Add: "Love it, if you can come!" Postcards are available outside and on the welcome center. NOTE: The postcards need regular letter stamp.
- Text, call, email, or personally invite someone to Easter Worship. Tell them about worship times, Easter breakfast and our family activity between services the Easter Journey.

February 2017 Period 08 - Financial facts.

- Total Revenue for the period \$287,226 (\$31k better than projected)
- Total Expenses for the period \$224,964 (\$661k lower than projected – Only non discretionary spending)
- Net Revenue for the period was \$62k (\$32.7k better than projected:)
- Total revenue continues to exceed the projected revenue in Nov-Feb This was due to additional envelope offerings and increased Preschool revenue.
- YTD, we are still missing our projected revenue mark for the Church and School by \$33k but this number is getting smaller every month – Praise be to God. Please continue to prayerfully consider your tithing.
- Capital Fund contributions for the period was \$3,979.
- Capital Fund contributions YTD is \$44,208. These dollars would normally go directly to the mortgage principal, but given our current budget situation they will be applied to our current mortgage balance.
- 2016-17 Enrollment Status.
 - Elementary is currently at 164 enrolled (93% of 2016-17 target)
 - Preschool is currently at 199 enrolled (Over 100% of 2016-17 target)
- 2017-18 Enrollment has begun.
 - Elementary is currently at 149 enrolled (93% of 2017-18 target)
 - Preschool is currently at 128 enrolled (69% of 2017-18 target)
