March 2017 Period 09 - Financial facts.

- Total Revenue for the period \$276,362 (\$21k better than projected)
- Total Expenses for the period \$227,801 (\$7k lower than projected Only non discretionary spending)
- Net Revenue for the period was \$48.5k (\$28.2k better than projected ©).
- Total revenue continues to exceed the projected revenue in Nov-Mar This was due to additional envelope offerings and increased Preschool revenue.
- YTD, we are missing our projected revenue mark for the Church

and School by \$12k – This is a phenomenal improvement over what I was projecting 4 months ago. Praise be to God! Please continue to prayerfully consider your tithing.

- Courtyard Special Offering exceeded our expectations, to date we have collected over \$21k. Thank you very much for your generous contributions. The project is on target and under budget. – The additional funds will be used for additional trees and lighting.
- 2016-17 Enrollment Status.
