The Lord's Supper: Our Understanding and Practice

The Lord's Supper is celebrated at this congregation in the confession and glad confidence that, as he says, our Lord gives into our mouths not only bread and wine but his very body and blood to eat and to drink for the forgiveness of sins and to strengthen our union with him and with one another. Our Lord invites to his table those who trust his words, repent of all sin, and set aside any refusal to forgive and love as he forgives and loves us, that they may show forth his death until he comes. Because those who eat and drink our Lord's body and blood unworthily do so to their great harm and because Holy Communion is a confession of the faith which is confessed at this altar, any who are not yet instructed, in doubt, or who are members of a different church other than The Lutheran Church—Missouri Synod, and yet desire to receive the sacrament, are asked first to speak with the pastor. April 2017 Period 10 - Financial facts.

- Total Revenue for the period \$277,295 (\$1k short of projection)
- Total Expenses for the period \$238,605 (\$8.5k lower than projected – Only non discretionary spending)
- Net Revenue for the period was \$38.6k (\$9.8k short of projection).
- YTD, we are missing our projected revenue mark for the Church and School by \$14k – This is a phenomenal improvement over what I was projecting 5 months ago. Praise be to God. Please continue to prayerfully consider your tithing.
- Capital Fund contributions for the period was \$4,559.
- Capital Fund contributions YTD is \$53,287. These dollars would normally go directly to the mortgage principal, but given our current budget situation and desperate need to maintain our property and assets, LCEF has agreed to allow us to reinvest 40% of these dollars (going forward) for property and maintenance improvements. 60% will continue to be applied to the mortgage principal You will see these details included upcoming Capital Campaign Events.
- 2016-17 Enrollment Status.
 - Elementary ended the school year at 164 enrolled (94% of 2016-17 target)
 - Preschool ended the school year at 198 enrolled (Over 100% of 2016-17 target)
 - o 2017-18 Enrollment has begun.
 - Elementary is currently at 152 enrolled (92% of 2017-18 target)
 - Preschool is currently at 140 enrolled (73% of 2017-18 target)
