The Lord's Supper: Our Understanding and Practice

The Lord's Supper is celebrated at this congregation in the confession and glad confidence that, as he says, our Lord gives into our mouths not only bread and wine but his very body and blood to eat and to drink for the forgiveness of sins and to strengthen our union with him and with one another. Our Lord invites to his table those who trust his words, repent of all sin, and set aside any refusal to forgive and love as he forgives and loves us, that they may show forth his death until he comes. Because those who eat and drink our Lord's body and blood unworthily do so to their great harm and because Holy Communion is a confession of the faith which is confessed at this altar, any who are not yet instructed, in doubt, or who are members of a different church other than The Lutheran Church—Missouri Synod, and yet desire to receive the sacrament, are asked first to speak with the pastor. What Lutherans Teach about Man and Sin

Lutherans teach that the first man and woman were created by God (Adam's body, from the dust of the ground, and Eve's, from the rib of Adam); that were given a rational and immortal soul (not being unintelligent or brutish) and were created for eternal life; and that they were created in the image of the LORD God, having a knowledge of God and His will and being righteous and holy in thoughts, desires, words, and deeds. (Gen. 1:26-28, 31; 2:7, 18-25; Eph.4:24; Col. 3:10). Lutherans also teach that Adam and Eve sinned as described in Genesis 3; that, as a result of this sin, all men are conceived and born in sin and are inclined to evil (having lost the image of God); that, as sinner, all of mankind stands condemned by God's holy Law to eternal suffering in hell; and that all people, as they are by nature, are unable to do Godpleasing works or reconcile themselves to God and thus escape his wrath and punishment. (Psalm 51:5; Gen. 6:5; 8:21; Rom. 3:10-20, 23; 5:12, 18-19; Gal. 3:10; James 2:10-11; Ezek. 18:20; Rom. 6:23; Isaiah 64:6; John 3:6; 15:5-6; Psalm 49:7-9).
