The Lord's Supper: Our Understanding and Practice

The Lord's Supper is celebrated at this congregation in the confession and glad confidence that, as he says, our Lord gives into our mouths not only bread and wine but his very body and blood to eat and to drink for the forgiveness of sins and to strengthen our union with him and with one another. Our Lord invites to his table those who trust his words, repent of all sin, and set aside any refusal to forgive and love as he forgives and loves us, that they may show forth his death until he comes. Because those who eat and drink our Lord's body and blood unworthily do so to their great harm and because Holy Communion is a confession of the faith which is confessed at this altar, any who are not vet instructed, in doubt, or who are members of a different church other than The Lutheran Church—Missouri Synod, and yet desire to receive the sacrament, are asked first to speak with the pastor. For further study see Matt 5:23f.; 10:32f.; 18:15-35; 26:26-29; 1 Cor 11:17-34.



Here at Trinity, we will silently stand along Indian School (in front of the church) with a Life Chain sign each Sunday in October from 1:00pm-2:00pm. The signs have these messages: Abortion Kills Children, Jesus Forgives And Heals, Adoption: The Loving Option, and Abortion Hurts Women. Come and join us in this difficult work; bring a bottle of water, a lawn chair if you want, and "silently speak" for those who cannot speak for themselves. (Warning: you can expect to be heckled by passing motorists.) In this one hour each Sunday, we usually see over 500 cars drive by. If you have any questions, see Pastor Bolte.

What Lutherans Teach about the Bible

Lutherans teach that all of the Bible and each and every word of the Bible (the 39 Old Testament and 27 New Testament canonical books) was given by inspiration of God and is therefore the true and unerring Word of God (II Peter 1:21; II Tim. 3:16; I Cor. 2:13; John 10:35; 17:17). Lutherans also teach that God has faithfully preserved His Word through the centuries. (Psalm 119:89; Isaiah 40:8; I Peter 1:25; Matt. 24:14,35). Since all of the Bible is God's true and unerring Word, Lutherans teach that the Bible is to be the source and judge of all Christian Doctrine. What is not according to God's Word is not to be taught as Christian Doctrine (Isaiah 8:20; Jer. 23:28, 31-32; Il Tim. 3:16-17; Acts 17:11). The Bible is to be its own interpreter; thus, passage interpretations which are not in accord with other clear passages of Holy Scripture are rejected (II Peter 1:20; Isaiah 8:20). Lutherans teach that the Bible should be diligently studied and heard; for it reveals to man the only way of salvation, which is through faith in Christ Jesus, and guides the Christian in living according to God's holy will (John 5:39; 20:31; II Tim. 3:15-17; Psalm 119:105).
