WORSHIP AT TRINITY

The Lord's Supper: Our Understanding and Practice

The Lord's Supper is celebrated at this congregation in the confession and glad confidence that, as he says, our Lord gives into our mouths not only bread and wine but his very body and blood to eat and to drink for the forgiveness of sins and to strengthen our union with him and with one another. Our Lord invites to his table those who trust his words, repent of all sin, and set aside any refusal to forgive and love as he forgives and loves us, that they may show forth his death until he comes. Because those who eat and drink our Lord's body and blood unworthily do so to their great harm and because Holy Communion is a confession of the faith which is confessed at this altar, any who are not yet instructed, in doubt, or who are members of a different church other than The Lutheran Church—Missouri Synod, and yet desire to receive the sacrament, are asked first to speak with the pastor. For further study see Matt 5:23f.; 10:32f.; 18:15-35; 26:26-29; 1 Cor 11:17-34.

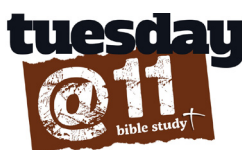


STUDY

LIFE CHAIN

Life Chain is a silent, pro-life witness that life is a gift from God, abortion kills children, and Jesus forgives all sins. In 2016, over 1600 "life chains" were held across the country. Here at Trinity, we will silently stand along Indian School (in front of the church) with a Life Chain sign each Sunday in October from 1:00pm-2:00pm. The signs have these messages: Abortion Kills Children, Jesus Forgives And Heals, Adoption: The Loving Option, and Abortion Hurts Women. Come and join us in this difficult work; bring a bottle of water, a lawn chair if you want, and "silently speak" for those who cannot speak for themselves. (Warning: you can expect to be heckled by passing motorists.) In this one hour each Sunday, we usually see over 500 cars drive by. If you have any questions, see Pastor Bolte.

ALL SAINTS' DAY

We will be celebrating "All Saints' Day" on Sunday, Nov 5, 2017. The word "saint" is from the Latin word sanctus and means "holy", and it means that you have been "set apart" to live a godly life. The Bible teaches us that a "saint" is one made "holy" and "set apart" through faith in Jesus Christ (see 1 Corinthians 1:2 for one of many examples). On All Saints' Day, we especially remember and thank God for those "saints" who have died in the faith and whom we look forward to seeing in the Kingdom of Heaven. As Lutheran Christians, we would never pray to, nor worship, the "saints" in any way, because we pray to and worship only the One, True and Only God, the Holy Trinity. Rather, we show the saints honor in three ways: (1) we thank God for their faith and life; (2) we see how God kept His promises to them and remember that He will keep His promises to us also; (3) we learn from their faith and life and are encouraged to live godly lives ourselves. The saints are a "great cloud of witnesses (Hebrews 12:1)" who surround us and motivate us to live holy lives.
