### Jesus Christ Is Risen Today



Matthew 28:1-10 April 12, 2020 Pastor Dave Bolte

It's not very often where you see the entire world reacting to one particular thing so strongly. The coronavirus has certainly made its presence known in the world! For many people, it has created a great deal of fear, worry, and even panic. Most of us have never seen the world react in such a way --- with the shutdowns and quarantines and "10 person" rule. This pandemic has made a **global impact.** 

Today we are here to celebrate the Resurrection of Jesus Christ from the dead! The Resurrection also makes a **global impact** – Christ died on the cross, and He rose from the dead, for every single person in every single country!

Jesus was **DECLARED TO BE THE SON OF GOD IN POWER** according to the Spirit of holiness by His resurrection from the dead! Romans 1:2

The resurrection of Jesus Christ from the dead proves that Jesus is the Son of God, Savior of the *entire* world! God performed such an amazing miracle in the *Resurrection* so that everyone would notice; so that every single person would pay attention and believe that Jesus is the Son of God, in the Savior of the *entire* world! In fact, in the book of Romans, the idea is that God the Father *circled* Jesus in the *Resurrection* as if to say, "This is the one! This is My Son! This is the Savior the entire world! Believe in Him!"

# Today, make sure you pay attention, and see what God the Father is showing you in the Resurrection of His Son!

And we all need a Savior. We don't need someone to save us from the *coronavirus*, or some other worldly threat; but we need Someone to save us from our sin and the guilt, shame, and death that comes with it. Sin is a worldwide plague that has infected every single human being in every single country throughout history. The sign of sin is death. We all know that someday we will die. That is what we need to be saved from: and that is why God sent His Son into the world!

Jesus, the one born in Bethlehem, took your sin, guilt, and shame to Jerusalem where He suffered terribly and died by crucifixion. He did this for you, as your substitute, in your place. His death earned your forgiveness. You now have peace with God through the death of the Lord Jesus Christ. On Third Day He rose from the dead, and in His *Resurrection*, you were given eternal life! You will not die but live! Jesus promises "Because I live, you also shall live!"

Eternal salvation is a gift that God freely gives to every single person in every single country throughout history. Today believe it for yourself! See the great miracle of the *Resurrection*! See that God "circled Jesus" for you: your sins are forgiven and you have been giving eternal life.

In faith, you can boldly and confidently saying that great Easter hymn "I know that my Redeemer lives!" Faith gives you a confidence, and assurance, and a boldness, for Christ, His Word,

and His Kingdom. The Resurrection of Jesus Christ changes your life!

The Resurrection, not only are your sins forgiven, and not only were you given new life; but you are brought into God's kingdom, you are literally changed from death to life, darkness to light, from an enemy of God to a child of God! A real transformation happens to you because of the Resurrection of the Lord Jesus Christ!

An easy way to think about it is that you **value His Word** and you **live in His Kingdom**.

The Word of God is powerful and active in our lives; it is God's power at work in and through you. God's Word of Law convicts you of your sin and leads you to repentance; God's Word of Gospel forgives you and empowers you to holy living. In the Word of God, you hear the voice of Christ as He speaks personally and directly to you. That's why the Bible is so important to us as conservative Lutheran Christians. In fact, if you need a Bible, I will give you one for free after church today. The resurrection of Jesus Christ changes us so that we want to hear His Word, so that we desire to be His disciples, so that we are ever growing as Biblically Literate and Doctrinally Sound People of God.

The Resurrection also drives you to live in God's Kingdom. You learn His morals, His values, and His ethics based on the 10 Commandments. You take God's Word the heart and you put it into practice. As we live in God's Kingdom by the power of the Resurrection, we learn to value

- + Authority in our lives
- + The value of every single life; even the unborn
- Guard and protect the marriage of one man and one woman in a lifelong commitment
- + Protect our neighbors possessions as if they are our own
- + Defend our neighbors reputation
- + And we guard our own hearts from the sins of coveting, pride, and unrepentant sin.
- + We learn to love our neighbors as ourselves
- + We learn to hate what is evil, and to cling to what is good
- + We confess Christ to our family and friends so that they too can have their sins forgiven to faith in Jesus Christ!

The Resurrection of Jesus Christ changes us; we hear and believe God's Word, and we live according to the values His Kingdom!

The Resurrection of Jesus Christ is a global event: it is the greatest miracle of all time; and it proves that Jesus is the Savior of every single person in every single country of the world!

Today may you believe it; trust in God's forgiveness for you, and be transformed by the power of the Resurrection!
